<u>Agenda/Consent Agenda:</u>

Committee Reports:

- **Secondary/ABE Policies:** Workload, time carding work done on Fridays, work related to changing rooms and ended the meeting with some light and happy notes from around the district.
- **E-5 Policies:** CARES funds and how that is used, schoology and what it is used for, who gets chosen to sub in a given building, teacher attendance, SpEd teachers don't get subs, signing up new members and that they are aware of benefits, cafeteria of music changing.
- **LCAT:** May 10th, new expectations being added to workload:
 - o mobile with new laptop or without a desktop
 - o common assessments in PLTs
 - o Seesaw

- o changing technology
- o secondary science, classes changing levels
- o social emotional curriculum
- o elementary science curriculum
- o secondary math curriculum
- Student Services
 - subs pulled from SpEd to cover regular ed courses
 - many SpEd openings (25 currently)
 - resource +
 - evaluation duties shifted to case managers
 - Team teaching teaching in unprepared areas
 - Evaluations due to Covid/DL fallout
 - New SOAR curriculum resource time management
 - Idea Workload Caps direct/indirect

<u>NEA Leadership Summit</u>

- Reflections from Ben Poupard
 - people need to feel connected
 - support teachers of color
 - losing members due to not seeing cost benefit
 - website having accurate information especially in regards to constitution and bylaws
 - using retirees as a valuable resource to reach potential members
 - use secure personal emails and phone numbers to avoid big brother
 - create positive public image through civic donations
 - NCLB has led to an increase in business vocabulary and strategies in schools
 - ALEC corporate \$ going to dismantle public education and unions, they promote report cards that focus on test scores, not growth. Sinclair media controls the narrative in local media
 - cycle stronger students leave for private schools, test scores drop, teachers get assessed on test scores
 - invites school board members and politicians to visit schools to see successes, keep the pressure up with regular communication
 - politics affect ALL of us if you want to "just teach", what you teach and how much you get paid are decided in the political arena

<u>New Business:</u>

- Constitution and Bylaws Change
 - Bylaws: Article 6, addition of being able to hold meetings in person, remotely or other electronic means, change was approved by unanimous vote
- Budget/Dues for 2021-2022
 - Current 1.0 FTE = \$911/yr \$60.74/pay period
 - 15 deductions from Oct 20 May 20
 - Dues increase, State = +\$10, National = +\$2 (estimated) => total increase \$12/yr or \$.80/pay period
 - Factors to consider when determining this budget: projected/actual number of members, communication in a pandemic difficult especially one on one which is our best tool, potential members having a loss of income due to pandemic
 - Proposal: Increase dues \$1/pay period or \$15/yr => \$926 total dues/yr

- Budget proposal was approved by a 90% in favor, 10% against
- Summer Committee on Policies
 - Looking for up to 6 members to do summer work (up to 24 hours @ \$32/hr) to look at practices, policies and protocols to make sure we are being good stewards of our time and finances, let Kelly Wilson know if interested
- Negotiations Update
 - Kidstop and Nurses have been working without a contract for 325 days
 - All 4 bargaining units are offered a 0% in year 2
 - The district is waiting to hear what the legislature will give to schools
 - Wear EM-O t-shirts on Wednesdays to support AESPs, ESPs, Nurses and Kidstop Instructors
 - Survey results for teacher contract
 - #1 salary
 - #2 workload
 - #3 benefits
 - #4 deferred compensation
 - negotiators followed up with members as requested
 - Listening Sessions with negotiators
 - Carol Fischer WVR, Tom Greve PL/ABE, Shawn Johnson OSH, Melissa Pederson WVR, Paul Terry MGMS/PL/FO/DLA, Dewey Anderson EDMN, Kelly Wilson EM-O
 - Thursday, May 27th, 2:30 High School, 3:30 Middle Level, 4:30 Elementary, email Kelly to get the Zoom link
 - Negotiators are willing to meet with any other interested parties, SpEd, ABE, OT, PT, Counselors, ECFE, ECSE, etc.
